AICTE in its 49<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Council held on 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2017 approved a package of measures to be implemented by all technical institutions approved by AICTE to improve the standards of technical education and to provide competent technical manpower for the nation.

AICTE has signed MoU with National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology(NIELIT) under Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology on 22<sup>nd</sup> June, 2017 AICTE & NIELIT have agreed for collaboration for conducting Employability Enhancement Training Program (EETP) whereby NIELIT will impart the requisite training and award credits for the training conducted on its own, to the registered students. NIELIT Centres/set-ups are required to perform the role and function of providing hands on skill training in Communication and all its related areas with such training centres/set-ups located preferably all over the country. The Training Centres/set-ups of NIELIT, as approved and recognized by NIELIT shall be known as and act/perform the role of "Training Providers" under the scheme to conduct Employability.
